HOW TO: HOST A SINGLE EXHIBITION GAME

- 1. Choose a time and gym.
 - a. Convert one of your practice times. 1hr 15 minutes is sufficient for a game.
 - b. Use vacant space adjacent to one of your practices.
 - c. Use vacant space from the Practice Schedules google sheet.
 - d. Use an additional permit be secured (weekends only).
 - e. If you are limited to a specific weeknight that you don't have a practice scheduled you'll have to trade practice times for that week with another team to get the weeknight that you need.
- 2. Email Mary Ellen at <u>permits@barrieroyals.ca</u> to secure your choice of gym & time.
- 3. Get a commitment from a visiting team.
- 4. <u>If using a practice permit:</u> Email Mary Ellen to convert your permit to a game (score clock, bleachers, insurance).
- 5. Email Mary Ellen at <u>permits@barrieroyals.ca</u> to request referees & score keepers (after opponent commitment).
- 6. Contact Greg MacMillan <u>finance@barrieroyals.ca</u> or Mary Ellen if you need a score book (coaches usually have a score book).
- 7. Register your exhibition game with OBA. (See "Registering Exhibition Games with OBA")

Paying for your exhibition game

Costs for your exhibition game will come out of your budget. You may ask visiting teams to pay a fee to participate in your exhibition game. The visiting team e-Transfers the fee that you set to <u>barrie.royals3@gmail.com</u> with a note that is for your team. That fee will be deposited to your team budget to offset your costs. Typically, teams will not pay any more than \$150.00 for a game.

Calculating costs

Permits	Free if using vacant space from the Permit Vacancies sheet. Free if using your practice time. Weekends have a minimum 3 hour cost Saturday costs about \$200.00 (varies) for a 3 hour time slot Sundays cost more than Saturdays.
	SCDSB has the most affordable weekend rates.
Referees	Costs vary depending on distance travelled to the game. Referees in the Barrie & District Association of Basketball Officials (BDABO) come from all across the county. Costs range from \$45 - \$75 per ref per game Count on \$120.00 / game as a good estimate.
Minor Officials	U10 - U14 require 2 people (clock & sheet). Count on \$30.00 / game. U15 - U19 require 3 people (add shot clock). Count on \$45.00 / game. You may provide your own experienced scorekeepers for an exhibition game. (free)
